

Feng Shui, originally known as 'Kan Yu', is about living in harmony with nature. By living in harmony, we are able to harness the beneficial energies (known as Qi) to improve the quality of our lives.

Originated over 1500 years ago, classical Feng Shui has always been split into two schools: San He and San Yuan. These schools and their fundamental theories have remained relatively unchanged since then.

Classical Feng Shui is a form of metaphysical science that can almost be fully explained by logic and principles. The roots of this science can be traced to the I-Ching (*The Book of Changes*).

San He deals with landforms: Structures or contours of the land, the appearance of the surrounding environment, and how they could influence the lives of those living in the vicinity. **San He** is a system where formulae are mainly based on the environment.

The **San Yuan** system focuses more on the aspects of time and how it affects the "Qi" of the property. A property's fortune changes after a 20-year cycles, after which the 'luck' expires unless the energies in the environment are renewed.
